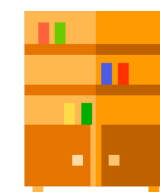
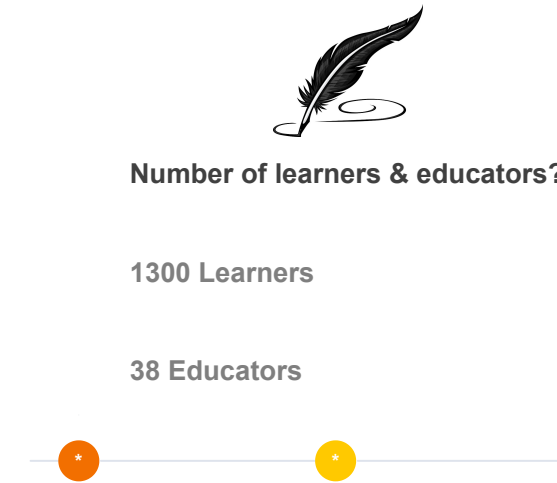

**7. Library**

*The school has identified a need for a Library, but there currently is not space for a Library. Requirements: Container: 6m x 3 m minimum Librarian that is funded Shelving Chairs, Bean Bags, Desks Carpets Posters Subject orientated books needed Fiction and non-fiction and different genres books are needed Library Computer A Library Management Software Programme Library Printer Computers for Learners*



**1. Psychologist Consultation Room**

The school has been allocated a Psychologist for 3 days per week and therefore needs private space for the Psychologist to meet with the learners, which is not available. Available spaces are between classes or at the side of the school close to the bathroom block. Area open between classrooms is 6 x 5 m

Soundproofing for privacy

The school requires painting, but requires the materials and the manpower to do it. Due to a lack of funds however, the school is unable to have it done.



**2. Sick Bay**

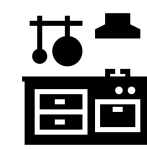
The school does not have a sick bay, because there is no space. The school has identified this as a great need because most of the children do not have parents at home that they can release them to during the course of the school day, should they fall ill. The area identified is next to existing classrooms close to the entrance, in case an ambulance needs access and for transport arrangements if the learner needs to go home.

**Requirements:**  
A bed, chair and a small table  
Container: 6 m x 3 m



**9. Printing Paper**

This is a great need at the school and the school only has a certain allocation but the need far outweighs the allocation received. For effective learning and teaching to take place the school therefore urgently requires printing paper on an ongoing basis.



**3. Additional Kitchen**

Initially the school had 400 learners and now it has 1300 learners so the kitchen is no longer sufficient for the number of learners it has to serve. With the additional kitchen the school can have the one kitchen serving the Grade 8 & 9 learners and the other kitchen serving the Grade 10-12 learners, which means that they can serve the entire learner population more effectively and in a shorter time period.

**10. Sports Clothes and Equipment needed for the sports codes and extra-mural activities offered at the School, such as:**

Soccer – district champs 2019 & current log leaders  
Chess – still in its fledging stages  
Drama – regional champs, Thola Festival National Champions (Durban2019)  
Netball – WC 2022 Champions (participated in DSTV National Championship)  
Rugby – still in its fledging stage  
The school is trying their best to offer the above-mentioned extra-mural activities to their learners. However due to a lack of funding the school does not have the required equipment to effectively train the Learners. Due to the lack of finances, their learners are also unable to afford the uniforms and gear that these extra-mural activities require.



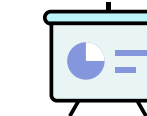
**4. Academic Programmes – including ICT integration into classroom practice**
